

This migration season began on almost the same date as last year. It started quietly from 7 February, when the first flocks were seen.

01/02/21: 13 over Zaragoza air base, Juan C. Troya.

03/02/21: 9 in Pego-Oliva marsh (V) Benigno Varillas.

04/02/21: a flock migrating over Constantina (SE) at 07.00h, Rafael Vicente; 4,044 are censused at Gallocanta (Z/TE) Francisco J. Sampietro (S.A.R.G.A.)

05/02/21: 60 over Les Masies de Voltregà (B) Lluís Copete; 22 over Ciempozuelos (M) José Monroy; 15 at Campillos lagoon (M) Yago Martínez.

06/02/21: 53 over Toledo, Javier Nicolau, 28 set off from Sotonera (HU) Francisco Quesada.

07/02/21: passage over San Miguel de Valero (SA) Cristina Giner; 14 over Leganés (M) Elver G., Mireia AF; 300 over Ainsa (HU) Mikel; 34 over Pau (GI) Guillem Arrufet; 144 over Avinyó (LL) Josep Bujons; passage over Les Masies de Voltregà (B) Arnau Soler (G.N.O.); 221 over Sant Martí d'Albars (B) Jordic Clavel; 40+60 over Agramunt (LL) Gerard Daniel, Francesc Pont; passage over Campins (B) Eloi Iglesias; 10 over Pago de San Clemente (CC) Martin Kelsey; 15 over River Noguera-Ribagorzana at Alfarrás (LL) Juanan Novales; 600+160 over Retuerta del Bullaque (CR) at 13:25h Gerardo García; 600 arrive at Gallocanta (TE/Z) from 17:50h Antonio Torrijo, having travelled 292 km in 4 hours.
